

PRIVACY STATEMENT

Your privacy is important to AWOL online. This privacy statement provides information about the personal information that AWOL online collects, and the ways in which AWOL online uses that personal information.

Personal information collection

AWOL online may collect and use the following kinds of personal information:

information about your use of this website (including number of visits, IP address, geographical location);

Cookies

When you visit AWOL online, we send one or more cookies – a small file containing a string of characters – to your computer or other device that uniquely identifies your browser. AWOL online also uses cookies in its advertising services to help advertisers and publishers serve and manage ads across the web. We may set one or more cookies in your browser when you visit a website.
