Big chains eye Hua Ḥin amid nment to act gove

■HUA HIN, THAILAND

The storm clouds that have been circling over Hua Hin these last few weeks have mirrored the dramatic twists and turns in the global financial markets, but it seems that it is an ill wind that blows nobody any good, as the big players of the food retail business in Thailand have either recently opened or are reported to be planning to open in or near the town soon.

Only three years ago there was but one 'supermarket' in the town itself, located inside the Shopping



Mall next to Satukarn Square, and then in quick succession a local family opened the Gee Untung store near the railway crossing and shortly after Market Village was completed and the Tesco Lotus store opened. Prior to that the planning to open in the area in the next 12 to 18 months, while there is a strong rumour that the Tesco Lotus in Market Village will close and be replaced by Tops.

Given the current economic climate, it may seem strange timing by these companies, and we may vet see some delay or cancellation of these plans, but there are other,

This year has seen the opening of a Makro and another Tesco Lotus in nearby Pranburi, plus the opening of 'boutique' supermarket Villa Market near the centre of Hua Hin. Reports are emerging that Big C, Carrefour and Foodland are all

non-financial reasons why these plans could be accelerated, namely a long delayed government bill, the Retail and Wholesale Act, which aims to regulate the rapid growth of hypermarkets, chain convenience stores and other large operators.

The government has pledged to dust off the draft of the bill prepared by the defunct National Legislative Assembly. Commerce Minister Chaiya Sasomsab said on Monday (13th October) that the ministry would move ahead with the draft after he met with the Senate Committee for Economy, Commerce and Industry, which has called on the government to speed up the retail legislation. Mr Chaiya said it would take about two weeks for the ministry to reexamine the proposed legislation and consult with the Council of State before the law could be sent to the cabinet for approval.

Critics say that the Interior Ministry's current urban planning and building codes are not adequate for the changed business environment, in which chains are squeezing out family businesses. The new law did not win support during the Thaksin Shinawatra administration, but even when it was approved by the Surayud Chulanont government, the National Legislative Assembly sent the draft back, citing many unclear issues.

Under the current draft, which focuses on protecting local retail businesses, existing giant retailers can expand but must comply with new regulations - restricting operating hours, size and proximity to the city centre - to leave room in the market for small players.

Boonchai Chokwatana, the chairman of the Senate Committee for Economy, Commerce and Industry, said the industry wanted the government to legislate the new act within its current term. He said the overall economy would eventually be hurt if there were no law to govern and regulate the local retail business.

"The act needs to be legally enforced within this administration," said Mr Boonchai. "Details of the act and other practices could be worked out later."

Somchai Pornrattanacharoen, chairman of the Thailand Wholesale and Retail Association and a member of the Senate Committee, said the government was being urged to submit the draft to the House before it closes its session on Nov 28.

Tops

It is clear that pressure is being exerted from both sides of the argument, but the supermarket chains will want to avoid the risk that their efforts to stall or amend the bill fail; whatever happens it will take months before it is law, so Hua Hin can probably expect the food giants to open sooner rather than later; on the face of it, more choice for the customers, but will it mean the further demise of our local shops? Given the experiences in the Western world, unfortunately it probably will.

Bond assassin's golden gun stolen

The £80,000 golden gun used in the 1974 James Bond film The Man With The Golden Gun has been stolen from studios in Hertfordshire.

The gun was noticed to be missing from Elstree Studios last Friday (10th October). It was made for the

film starring Sir Roger Moore and Christopher Lee. Lee plays Bond's nemesis Scaramanga, who kills using the gun made from a cigarette case, a lighter and a pen. The studios hope the golden gun will be offered to a memorabilia dealer. It is then hoped the thief will be able to be traced via the dealer.

The gun was in the care of Elstree Props, a firm which is based at the studios. Staff have no idea when the gun was taken, but it was discovered missing on Friday.

A spokeswoman for Hertfordshire Police said: "We were called to Elstree Studios in Borehamwood at 1325 BST after a report of a theft of a prop, which was the golden gun. "Inquiries are ongoing."

In the film, largely filmed in Thailand, when Bond




The beautiful Caterina Murino, who appeared in the latest Bond movie 'Casino Royale', is not a suspect

receives a golden bullet inscribed with 007, he is distracted from his mission.



APPLE RECALL IPHONE AFTER TOASTER FAULT

■ APPLE has been forced into an embarrassing recall of the entire first batch of its long awaited iPhone 3G after users reported problems with its on-board toaster.

Carl Knutz, an early adopter of San Andreas, California, said his two-slot iPhone produced one raw slice of toast and one that was



Apple's iPhone toaster guide burnt to a cinder and inedible. He said the problem was particularly frustrating as the iPhone's built-in roasting oven and low fat

grill "worked a treat".

Mr Knutz said: "I was sold the iPhone as the perfect solution for satisfying all my breakfast time needs. I could read emails, surf the web, grill some bacon and do toast all at the same time with the one gadget. Well I can't, the toast is rubbish."

Despite the toaster glitch most users are reporting themselves delighted with the iPhone. Bobby Killitz, 23, a glasses wearer, also of San Andreas, said he had cooked an entire chicken dinner in his phone, and it had emailed him to tell him when it was ready.

Danny Kravitz, 25, the brother of a musician, said his phone had babysat his 11-month old daughter while he went to a bar and did not email him when she started crying, as it knew it was nothing serious.

Even so Apple user forums are

buzzing with complaints about the quality of iPhone toast and the company's boffins are said to be working around the clock to sort the problem.

Steve Jobs has put up a personal video message on the Apple website apologising for the toaster glitch but reassuring users that it is a software issue that will be sorted soon.

Mr Jobs said: "We updated the iPhone software after all our laptops overheated and blew up but that appears to have affected the element in the toaster. Or maybe it just needs a new washer."

Meanwhile it has emerged that all the first batch of iPhones have also been built without any microphones being installed. This was not discovered until all of them had been sent to the shops as no one had thought to use one to make a phone call.

English corner

Have you ever wondered where a certain phrase comes from, or what it really means? Every week we will expand your knowledge of English and its etymology with a different word or saying. This week it is...

Son of a gun

This is a slang term present in American and British English which can be used approvingly, disparagingly or to express surprise. In British naval slang this term refers to a child of questionable parentage conceived on the gun deck, hence 'son of a gun'. However, children born on board British naval vessels to enlisted men were referred to as a 'true son of a gun'.

When a Royal Navy vessel entered a port it was common for local prostitutes to visit the ship and elicit custom from the sailors. The sailors and prostitutes then had sexual relations, usually on one of the gun decks beside the many guns carried, one of the few places Able and Ordinary Seaman could obtain some sort of privacy. Should the prostitute subsequently fall pregnant by the sailor, she would then attempt to obtain compensation from the father or the navy for the upkeep of the child. This was usually not forthcoming and

the father's name would be withheld. When it was fairly certain that the child had been conceived upon board one of His Majesty's vessels, the infant would be entered into the ship's records as 'child born to gun number X', the X denoting the gun position the sailor responsible for the errant behaviour was allocated-to, his name being omitted to maintain probity. These children born in this manner had no father's name on any official records and the male ones were referred to by knowing sailors as being 'sons of guns', a term denoting illegitimacy and contempt. Sometime during the late 1990s or early 2000s, the term "bitch", or "son of a bitch" began to become more publicized than previously in the United States and other Western countries. Due to this, usage of "son of a gun" as a euphemism for "son of a bitch" has decreased significantly, though "son of a gun" is still sometimes used humorously.
