Panic over as tests prove negative for H1N1 virus; fatality caused by pneumonia, common flu

■ HUA HIN. THAILAND

For a brief period earlier this week. both the Marriott Hotel and San Paulo Hospital were closed down as fears swept the town of an outbreak of the much hyped 'Swine flu' after a German woman, Mrs Barbel Wilhelmine, 65, who had been staying at the hotel and had been taken to the hospital, died on her way to Bangkok.

Initial reports had said that the new flu strain, H1N1, had been found in her, but later reports said that it had been common influenza and pneumonia that had caused her death.

Mrs Wilhelmine arrived in Thailand on May 12 with her husband, and symptoms.

They then drove to Hua Hin and stayed in the hotel for about a week before having chest pains and breathing difficulties on May 16.

Have you ever wondered where a certain phrase comes from, or what it really means? Every week we will expand your knowledge of English and its etymology with a different word or saying. This week it is...

Draw a blank

This phrase originates from the lottery that was established in Tudor England. Elizabeth I, like the monarchs of other European countries at the time, was short of money and decided to copy rival nation states by instituting a national lottery. The money so raised was intended to go towards the 'reparation of the havens and strength of the Realm and towards further public works'. She signed the license granting the lottery in 1567 (not so much a signature, more a craft project).

Lotteries at that time worked by putting tickets with the participant's names on them into a 'lot pot'. An equal number of notes, some with the prizes written on them and some of which were blank, went into another pot. Pairs of tickets were drawn simultaneously from the two pots. It is easy to see how a failure to succeed came to be associated with drawing a blank.

Sir William More (1520-1600), when he found time to spare from his numerous other posts, which included 'Her Majesty's Deputy Master of the Swans', was the 'Treasurer of the Lottery in Surrey'. The Loseley Manuscripts are a unique archive of the More-Molyneux family who have for centuries lived in beautiful Tudor manor house Loseley Park. The manuscripts contain a unique record of life in Tudor and Stuart England and include More's description of the lottery: "A verie rich Lotterie … without any blancks."

And so it should have been. The tickets cost ten shillings each - at a time when labourers were paid about a shilling a day. The prizes included silver plate and tapestry. Although the first time that someone 'drew a blank' was in the 16th century, the phrase wasn't recorded in print until the 19th, in Washington Irving's Tales of a Traveller, 1824, in which the plot involves a character being given credit for something he hadn't done: "It is like being congratulated on the high prize when one has drawn a blank."

Later in the 19th century it became used in a general figurative sense to mean to be unsuccessful in a venture or search of any kind.

New turtle nesting ground found

THAP SAKAE, THAILAND

A resident of Thap Sakae District in Prachuap Khiri Khan has discovered a nesting ground for green turtles at a site earmaked for a coal-fired plant by the Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand.

A chance discovery, it was made by a local, Pawinee Wongnen, on May 4 after she went for a walk that morning and spotted a dead baby turtle next to a hole in the ground on the sandy beach. Curious, she dug up the hole with bare hands and watched in amazement as others crawled out of the hole and made their way to the sea.

She marked the place and returned later with a team in employ of the Marine and Coastal Resources Research Centre that is based in the province. Among them was Atichart Inthongkam, an academic involved in fishery research along the Gulf of Thailand. They dug up around the hole to a depth of 80 centimetres and found eight more baby turtles.

"We found 118 eggs that had already hatched and another 10 that failed to hatch," Atichart said, adding that it was only the third instance - after Koh Kram island off mainland Chon Buri and Koh Kra off Nakhon Si Thammarat - that a nesting place for green sea turtles has been found on the Gulf of Thailand coast.

Sea turtles prefer quiet beaches far from human settlement for nesting, he explained, and saw this as a good development because he can look to the future with hope for the baby turtles, when they grow up, will return here to lay eggs.

The centre is presently nursing 26 young sea turtles in various stages of infirmity brought to it by the locals, and once they become strong enough it would release them to the sea.

The green turtle is listed by CITES in its Appendix I as among the most endangered species threatened with extinction.

■ LONDON, ENGLAND

Speed camera rakes in £1m in five months

A temporary speed camera close to roadworks on a dual carriageway caught 100 motorists a day for five months, clocking up fines of nearly £1m.

The camera, on the busy A316 Country Way in Hanworth, caught 16,213 drivers speeding between June and November last year.

With charges for speeding consisting of a £60 fine and three penalty points, the speed camera was responsible for £973,000 in fines and 50,000 in penalty points.

The camera was set up next to roadworks on the dual carriageway to enforce a 30mph speed limit on the road, which normally has a speed limit of 50mph.

The information, released via the Freedom of Information Act, also revealed that the temporary camera caught 11,010 heading out of London and 5,203 driving in on the busy commuter route.

The maintenance work was carried out on the road to improve the roadmarking, signage and street lighting and resurfacing of the viaduct. However, the drastic drop in speed left many drivers unimpressed as they found the drop from 70mph, from the M3, to 30mph, too much and were captured speeding.

A further six other temporary cameras raked in £2.2m, including £616,000 in fines from a camera on the M1 in Mill Hill, North London, and £374,000 from a camera on the A40 in Denham, West London, it was revealed this week.

A spokesman from anti speed camera group Speedcameras.org said: "The speed camera on the A316 illustrates what a cash cow cameras have become. If they were capable of getting drivers to slow down then ask yourself why the number of drivers caught have consistently increased.

"That fact should be enough to tell the authorities a different approach is required to road safety, but when cameras are capable of raising £1m in revenue that's unlikely to happen anytime soon."

A spokesman for the Camera Partnership in Kent, said: "We remain very concerned that so many motorists disregard the temporary speed limits on roadworks sites.

"Drivers are at risk in roadworks where the lanes may be narrower, the layouts change and there is no hard shoulder for broken down vehicles."

Skydiver's plummets 6,000ft without chute

A skydiver had a miracle escape after he plummeted 6,000ft when his parachute was opened too late. James Boole, from Tamworth, Staffordshire, pulled his ripcord just seconds before he hit the ground. The 31-year-old father-of-one was in Russia filming another skydiver for a TV documentary when he

says his partner signalled too late and he opened his chute two seconds before hitting the deep snow of a mountain top at 100mph.

Mr Boole broke his back and ribs, bruised a lung and chipped some of his teeth. He was rushed to hospital in Moscow before being flown back to the UK in a body brace and is now recovering at home.

The mechanical engineer has been parachuting for 12 years and has completed more than 2,000 jumps.

Authorities are looking a man they've dubbed the "Nicotine Ninja" believed to be responsible for stealing \$120,000 worth of cigarettes.

Authorities said the suspect is completely clad in dark clothing and covers half his face with a black cloth when he breaks into liquor stores in the middle of the night. The man is believed to be responsible for 118 burglaries across the Jefferson County area during the last two years.






