Another prestigious event is taking place at Black Mountain next month

as the fifth edition of the Royal Trophy golf championship played between the continents of Europe and Asia has been scheduled to take place on 7-9 January 2011. Team captains Colin Montgomerie and Naomichi Joe Ozaki have picked star studded teams featuring the likes of Henrik Stenson, Edoardo Molinari and Peter Hanson for Europe, and Ryo Ishikawa and Tongchai Jaidee for Asia.







The hottest chilli in the world grown in Cumbria

Chilli farmer Gerald Fowler has officially grown the hottest chilli in the world – in a greenhouse in Cumbria.

Gerald Fowler, a full-time chilli farmer for five years, crossed three of the hottest varieties to produce the fiercest pods known to man.

His Naga Viper rates an astonishing 1,359,000 on the Scoville scale, which measures heat by the presence of the chemical compound capsaicin.

Experts at Warwick University tested the chilli and the Guinness Book of World Records approached Gerald to include it their 2012 edition as the world's hottest.

When they grow chilli in India or the Caribbean they're used to the heat and the drought. When they're grown over here I think they fight back against the harsher climate and produce even more heat,' said Gerald

He sells the chilli as a sauce but says he's getting most interest from growers keen to get their hands on the seeds.

"It's painful to eat," said Gerald, 52, who runs the Chilli Pepper Company, in Cark-in-Cartmel.

'It's hot enough to strip paint.'

Cheesy Stilton beer has 'unique taste'

Two iconic British tastes, Stilton cheese and real ale, have been fused together for a new beer, The Blue Brew, just in time for the festive season.

Costing £2.10 (100 baht) a bottle, the cheesy beverage is available from Belvoir Brewery, which is behind drinks such as Oatmeal Stout and Star Bitter.

The Stilton is infused into the beer during the fermenting process, creating a unique smooth taste and a light creamy texture. It also contains beer wort, which, according to the brewer, allows the flavour of the Stilton to really shine through.

Nigel White, secretary of the Stilton Cheesemakers Association, said: 'People often think of Stilton as a cheese just for Christmas and forget how versatile it is. It has often been used as an ingredient for a wide range of dishes in cooking and now its by-product, whey, has been used to create a delicious beer, which is the perfect accompaniment to any festive fayre!'

'We know that the cheese is incredibly versatile and transforms the simplest of everyday snacks; we now also know it can add real character to beer!' he continued.

Do you wonder why we say certain things, or what they really mean? Each week we will examine a different word or phrase and tell you how it came about. This week it is.. A red rag to a bull

A deliberate provocation, sure to bring about an adverse reaction.

In the 17th century, to wave a red rag at someone was merely to chatter

with them - 'red rag' was then a slang term for the tongue. This usage is cited in print as early as 1605 and is nicely illustrated in Francis Grose's definition in The Classical Dictionary of the Vulgar Tongue, 1785: "Shut your potatoe trap, and give your redrag a holiday."

The waving of a cloth rag at an animal to distract it may have been a common practice for centuries, but it wasn't until the 1700s that it was documented in print. The animal in question wasn't, as we might suppose, a bull. The first creature known to be susceptible to rag waving was that most dim-witted of birds, the pheasant. This was cited in Trenchard and Gordon's religious essays, Cato's Letters, 1724:

Foxes are trapann'd [trapped] by Traces, Pheasants by a red Rag, and other Birds by a Whistle; and the same is true of Mankind.

Next come vipers, which were also thought to be adversely affected by red rags, as was recorded in The Times in March 1809: "Truth to a lawyer was like a red rag to a viper - it extracted his venom."

Bulls come rather a long way down the list of red rag sensitive beings found in early citations. Before them we find turkeys and, not to be left out, Frenchmen - as in Catherine Gore's Memoires of a Peeress, 1837:

"They [the English] have no ardour for gratuitous quarrels; they do not fire up like a turkey-cock or a Frenchman, at sight of a red rag."

It wasn't until 1873 that someone decided that bulls were to be added to the list, when Charlotte Yonge included an allusion in the novel Pillars of the House:

"Jack will do for himself if he tells Wilmet her eyes are violet; it is like a red rag to a bull."

The inclusion of bulls to the list was rather misguided. Bulls don't have the optical equipment to distinguish red from other colours, so the 'red rag to a bull' phrase gives the wrong impression. It is generally accepted that bulls are enraged by the waving of the cloth rather than its colour and that a green rag would work just as well.

Les grands du Jazz

Joe Zawinul

Un jazzman européen émigre à New York en 1959



Joe Zawinul débarque à New York en 1959 avec 800 dollars en poche pour étudier à la Berkeley School of Music et est rapidement engagé par Maynard Ferguson pour jouer à New York. George Wein, le producteur d'Ella Fitzgerald, cherche justement un pianiste. Joe Zawinul l'impressionne tant que Dinah Washington l'engage sur le champ. Plusieurs albums suivront.

Joseph Erich Zawinul, né en 1931 à Vienne, Autrichien et Tzigane, est certainement le claviériste et pianiste le plus impressionnant des 30 dernières années du XXe siècle.

Il réussit à s'imposer d'entrée dans le monde des jazzmen noiraméricains, ce qui dans les années 50 et 60 ne s'était encore

jamais produit. Il vit avec des musiciens noirs et est très populaire.

Il refuse poliment la première proposition de Miles Davis : "Je ne suis pas encore prêt. Attends un peu. Plus tard, nous écrirons ensemble l'histoire de la musique".

Il reste avec Cannonball Adderly ("le saxophoniste le plus sous-estimé de l'histoire du jazz") de 1961 à 1969. Les critiques de jazz demandent sans arrêt à Cannonball Adderly quand il va enfin engager un pianiste noir. "Trouvez-moi un meilleur que celui-ci et je le remplacerai".

Joseph Zawinul a grandi dans un milieu modeste à Vienne. Son père joue de l'accordéon à l'occasion et sa mère a une bonne oreille musicale et un don pour le chant. Elle met son fils dans un cours privé, mais le professeur abandonne rapidement : "Mettez plutôt votre fils au Conservatoire de Vienne, il a un talent hors du commun, comprend très vite et a une oreille extraordinaire". Au Conservatoire de Vienne il bénéficie de cours gratuits et y fait la connaissance de Friedrich Gulda.

En 1943, la comédie musicale Stormy Weather l'a influencé à jamais et l'album "Heavy Weather" (1977) avec WEATHER REPORT s'y rapporte directement.

A New York (Cannonball est le témoin), il épouse Maxine qu'il a connue à Birdland et qui est, à l'époque, le premier bunny de Playboy.

De Cannonball Adderlay à Miles Davis

60 albums vont suivre: "Mercy, Mercy, Mercy" avec le Cannonball Adderly Quintet et Dinah Washington est l'enregistrement le plus vendu (1 million d'exemplaires). Zawinul y joue du piano électrique Fender pour la première fois dans l'histoire du jazz. Miles Davis est tellement impressionné par le son chaud et unique, ainsi que par la force d'expression de ce piano qu'il en achète un aussitôt pour Herbie Hancock. Wir stehen vor der Jazz, Rock, Pop-Fusion, Details in der nächsten Nummer.

En bref: "In A Silent Way" de Miles Davis, tout comme l'album "Hot Rat" (1969) de Frank Zappa sont entrés dans l'histoire.

Joe Zawinul est resté deux ans avec Miles Davis. Ce sont les plus grands moments de l'histoire électro-acoustique moderne et ce, grâce aux compositions de Zawinul.


Magpie annual (right).

Hughton was sacked for his insistence on getting the club promoted, reducing the wage bill, installing the team in the top half of the Premiership and stubbornly refusing to crash helicopters into the car park.
